In view of the forty-year history of the Austrian Ludwig Foundation and its task of promoting and purchasing works of art for Austria's state galleries, the symposium Aesthetics, Ethics, Identity - Museum of the 21st Century, to be held at mumok in Vienna on November 19 and 20, 2021 is dedicated to examining current and future perspectives of museum collections. Considering the growing awareness—on an aesthetic as well as an institutional level—of the need to pursue a more inclusive approach to collection practices, i.e. one that takes into account socio-cultural diversity, the lectures and discussions will address important key words that are marked by controversy, such as transculturalism, diversity, and cultural heritage and their complicated relationship to processes of globalization.
